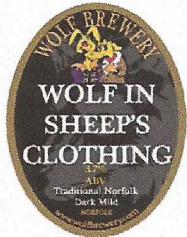




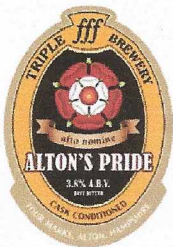
Radgie Gadgie 4.8% ABV

A strong, easy drinking northern ale, with balanced hops, fruit and malt and a long, lingering finish. Champion Strong Bitter of Britain award 1998.



Wolf In Sheep's Clothing 3.7% ABV

This traditional Norfolk mild has a malty aroma with fruity undertones. Lightly hopped with Fuggles and Goldings this beer has a long clean finish.

Siba Regional Winner Silver 2011

A traditional amber bitter brewed using water from the Hampshire chalk hills. Full and clean tasting, initially malty then citrus fruit and resinous hop build to a quenching bitter finish.



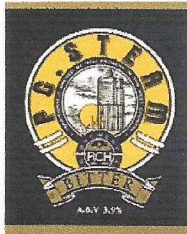
Jorvik Blonde 3.8% ABV

Flaxen Blonde ale with hoppy bitterness. Fruity with the flavours of peaches and melon. A Sweet, smooth light hop.



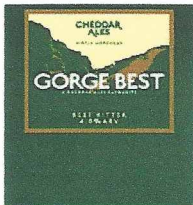
Side Pocket for a Toad 3.6% ABV

PG Steam 3.9% ABV

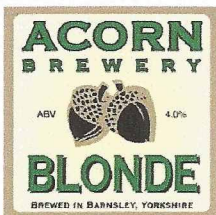
This complex multi layered mid brown ale has a floral hop aroma with medium bodied hop, bitter taste with some fruit and sweetness.



Gorge Best 4.0 % ABV

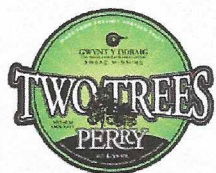
Supreme Champion Beer of Britain 2008
